

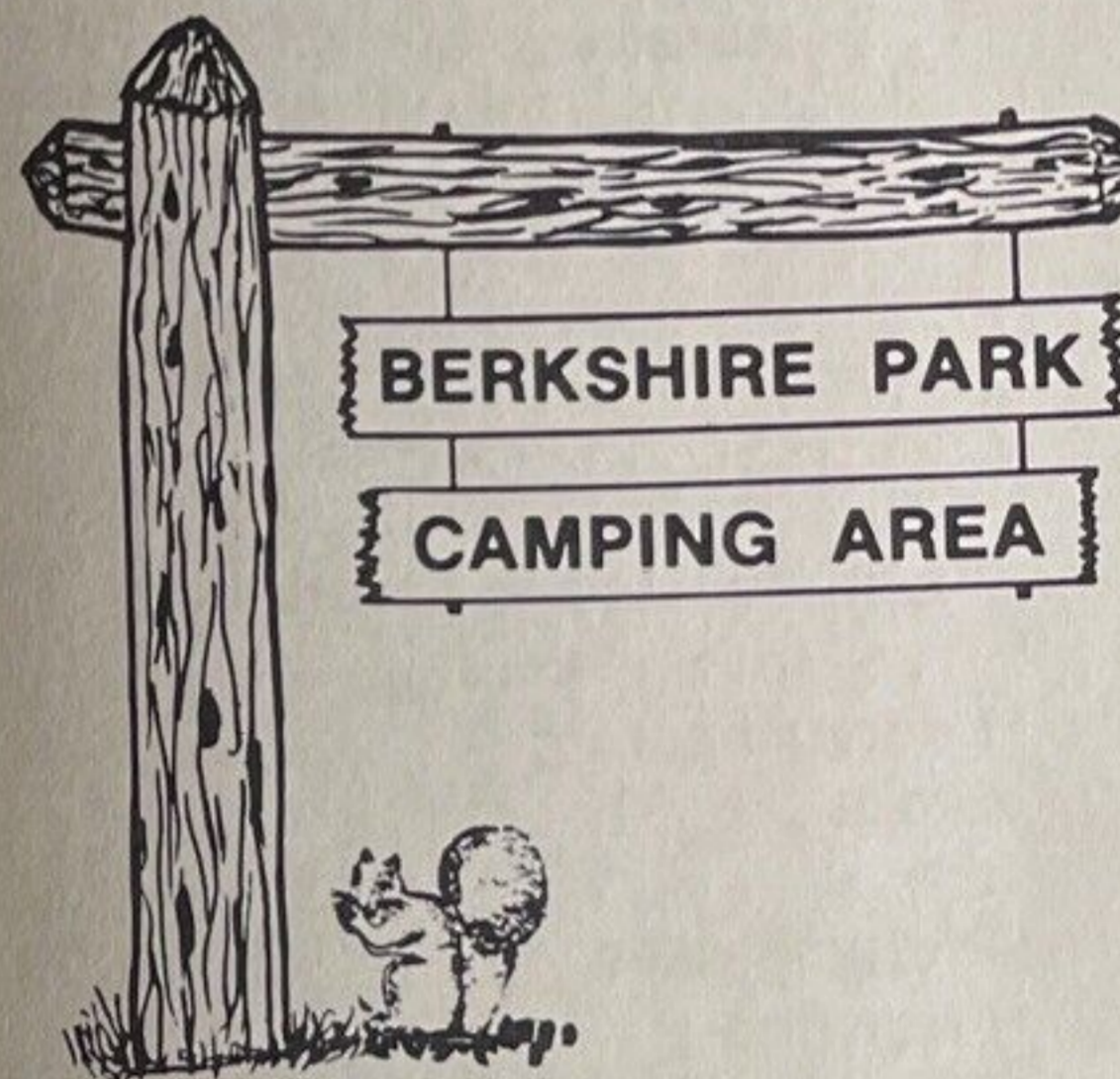
From Mass. Pike take Exit 3 (Westfield) to Rte. 20 West. After toll booth take right onto Rtes. 202-10 South for 1.3 miles. At lights take right onto 20 West. Go 11.2 miles. At lights in Huntington take Rte. 112 North for 14 miles. At the light in Wortbington take right onto Old Post Rd. Stay far right. (Do not take North 112-E 143) Corners Grocery store will be on your left. Take Old Post Rd. 1.2 miles. Take left onto Harvey Rd. at sign for campground.

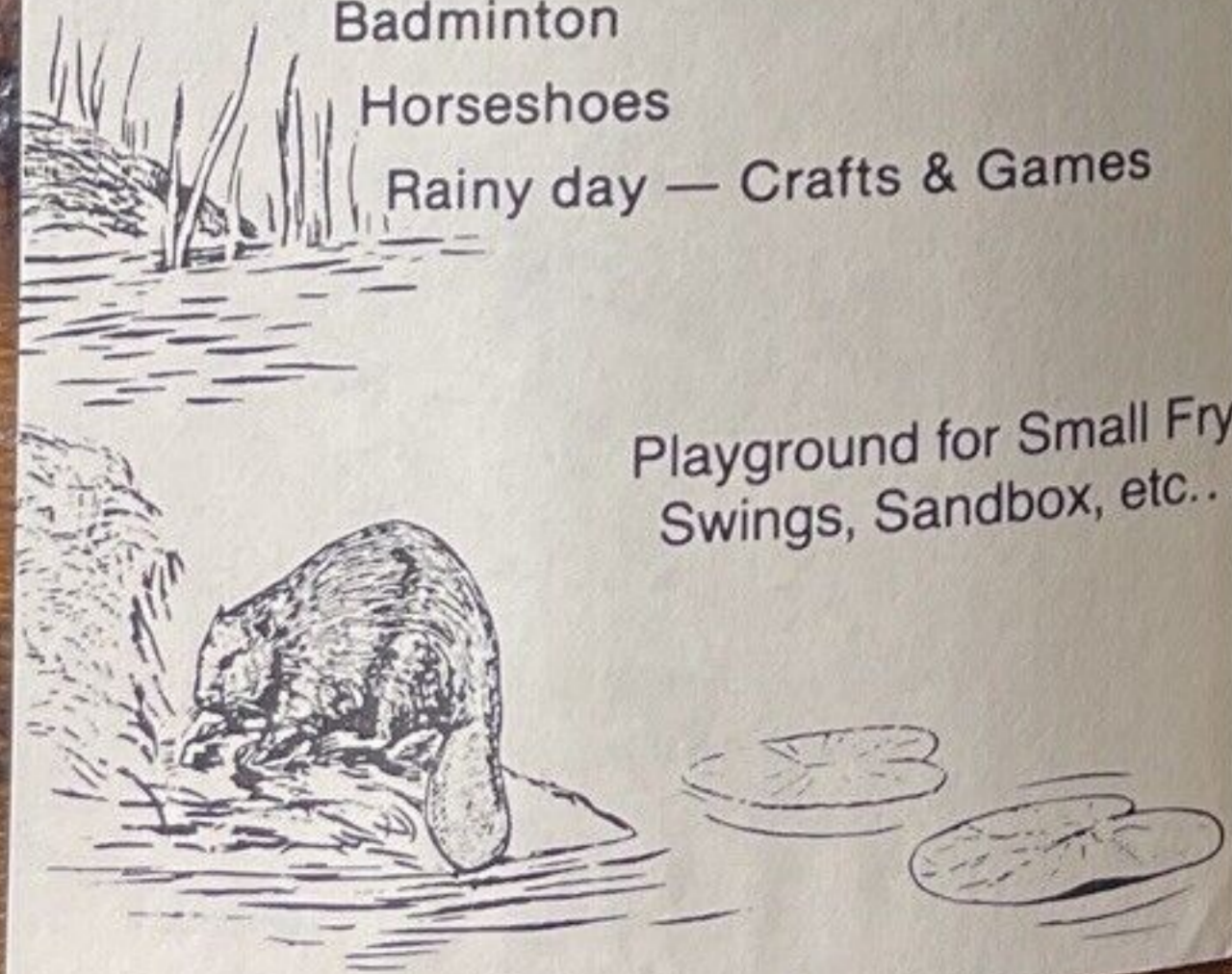

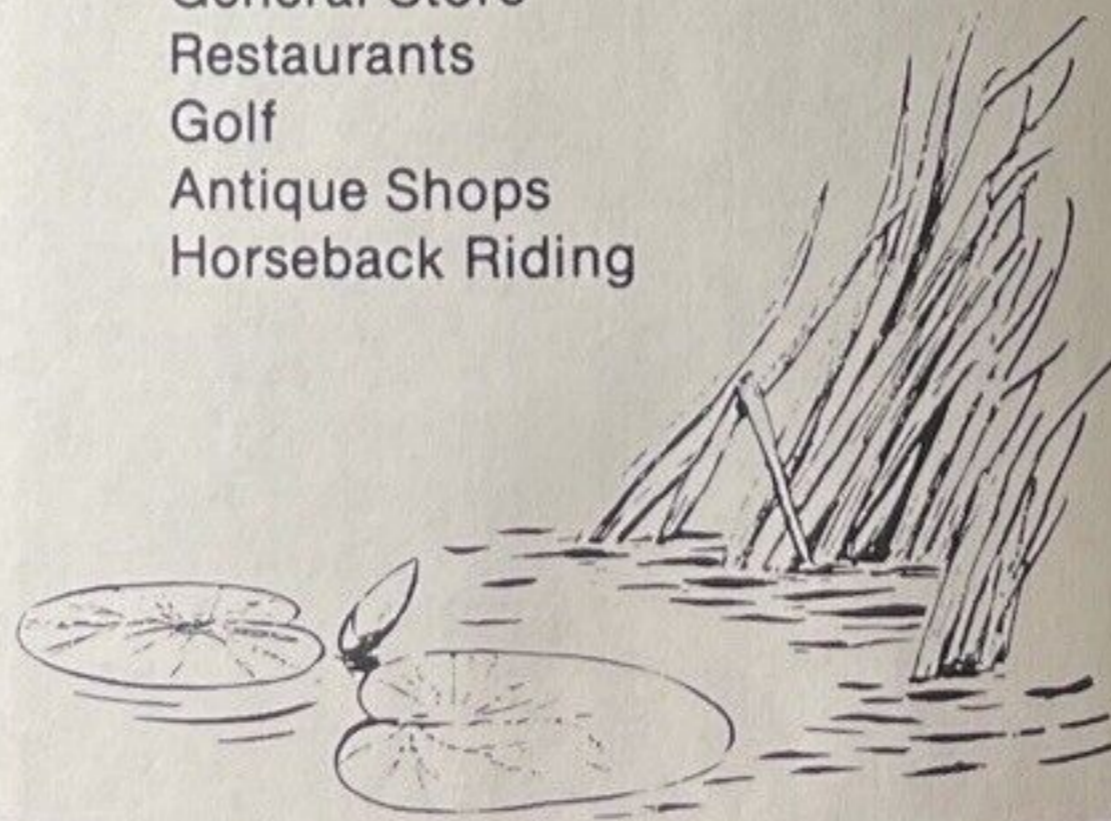
