I enclose copy of the description in the deed from E. H. Brewster to Emory B. Bruce and the description in the two deeds to Brewster therein referred to.

I also enclose copy of the description in the mortgage from Wm. F. Leonard to the First Parish in Worthington and copy of the entry of foreclosure.

I have not been able to find any deed to the town or church of the Common. I enclose copy of the description of the Town Hall Lot which may be ^{of} interest. I also enclose copy of the description of a deed from Zacheus Hanchet to the town in 1791. I take it this was the Common on which the church stood before it was moved to its present location. This land was later conveyed away by the town: part of it to Kingman and part to some one else. I shouldn't have included this description but ran across it and thought it might be of interest.
